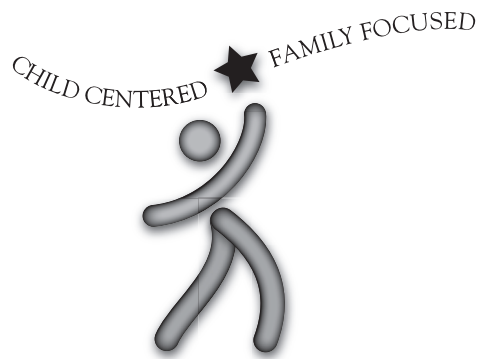

WATCH

The **Watch Program** is one of several programs within the Community Child Guidance Clinic which provide home-based therapeutic services to families. Individualized planning and intensive case management are components of the WATCH Program.

The primary goal of the **WATCH Program** is to maintain children in their homes and communities. All referrals come through the Department of Children and Families and all families referred must be DCF involved.

PROFESSIONAL STAFF

Watch Workers

The *Watch Workers* are clinical social workers with training and experience in providing home-based services, conducting psychiatric evaluations and treating families.

Watch Mentors

The *Watch Mentors* have extensive training and experience working with children and adolescents.

SERVICES

- Goal-focused family therapy in the home
- Crisis intervention and 24-hour crisis response
- Intensive case management including consulting with schools, community agencies and other professionals, accessing resources and coordinating services
- Child-specific Team meetings with family members and professionals.
- Parent education and support
- Goal-focused, therapeutic mentoring of children and adolescents.
