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## **PROGRAM GOALS**

- Stabilization and maintenance of children with serious disorders in their homes and communities.
- Prevention of hospitalization through crisis intervention.
- Identification of factors interfering with the child and family's use of more traditional outpatient services.
- Improvement of quality of fit between child and family to optimize developmental progress.

## **ELIGIBLE POPULATION**

- Children who can be discharged from Psychiatric hospitals or residential treatment facilities with additional in-home support.
- Children in acute psychiatric crisis for whom hospitalization is being considered.
- Children for whom traditional outpatient treatment is insufficient to maintain them appropriately in the community.

## **SERVICES PROVIDED**

IICAPS Services, which rely upon the creation of a working partnership between the child, the family and the treatment team, include:

- Comprehensive assessment of the treatment needs of the child and family.
- Psychological and psychiatric evaluation.
- Development and implementation of a comprehensive treatment plan.
- Time limited family, individual and couples psychotherapy.
- Crisis response 24 hours/7 days per week.
- School consultation.
- Parent guidance and training in behavioral management techniques.
- Clinically informed case management and case coordination.
- Multi-systems collaboration and coordination.
- Culturally competent intervention.

## **UNIQUE SERVICES**

- IICAPS teams are able to work with families for up to six months.
- Services can vary in intensity from 3 to 20 hours per week depending upon the needs of the individual child and family.
- Service hours are flexible and responsive to the family's routine.
